A BILL

To clarify that the Upper Missouri River Breaks National Monument does not include within its boundaries any privately owned property, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Upper Missouri River
3 Breaks Boundary Clarification Act”.

4 **SEC. 2. PRIVATELY OWNED PROPERTY EXCLUDED FROM**
5 **MONUMENT.**

6 (a) BOUNDARY CLARIFICATION.—The Upper Mis-
7 souri River Breaks National Monument, established by
8 Presidential proclamation 7398 on January 17, 2001,
9 shall not include within its boundaries any privately owned
10 property.

11 (b) MAP.—The Secretary shall keep a map of the
12 Monument reflecting the boundary clarification in sub-
13 section (a) on file and available for public inspection in
14 the appropriate offices of the Director of the Bureau of
15 Land Management, Department of the Interior.
