- 9 (b) Observances and Ceremonies.—Section
- 10 116(a) of title 36, United States Code, is amended by

- 1 striking "the last Monday in May" and inserting "May
- 2 30".
- 3 (c) Proclamation.—The President is authorized
- 4 and requested to issue a proclamation calling upon the
- 5 people of the United States to observe Memorial Day as
- 6 a day for prayer and ceremonies that show respect for
- 7 American veterans of wars and other military conflicts.
