A BILL

To require that any reductions in payment rates for Medicare home respiratory medication nebulizer drugs be offset by an equal increase in reimbursement for home respiratory medication professional services.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Home Respiratory
- 5 Medication Patient Protection Act of 2002".

1	SEC. 2. OFFSETTING MEDICARE PAYMENT REDUCTIONS
2	FOR HOME RESPIRATORY MEDICATION
3	NEBULIZER DRUGS BY INCREASES IN REIM-
4	BURSEMENT FOR HOME RESPIRATORY MEDI-
5	CATION PROFESSIONAL SERVICES.
6	Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if on or
7	after the date of the enactment of this Act the Secretary
8	of Health and Human Services effects a reduction in pay-
9	ment rates for home respiratory medication nebulizer
10	drugs under part B of title XVIII of the Social Security
11	Act, the Secretary shall provide for an increase in the pay-
12	ment rates for home respiratory medication professional
13	services under such part in a manner so that the aggre-
14	gate additional payments resulting from such payment in-
15	crease are designed to be equal to, and offset, the aggre-
16	gate decrease in payments resulting from such payment
17	reduction.
