## A BILL

To amend chapter 71 of title 5, United States Code, to provide that the same annual reports which are currently being furnished by the Social Security Administration be required of all Government agencies which are authorized to grant official time to any of their employees, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Official Time Report-  
5       ing Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPORTS RELATING TO OFFICIAL TIME.**

2       Section 7131 of title 5, United States Code, is  
3 amended by adding at the end the following:

4       “(e)(1) Each agency shall submit to each House of  
5 the Congress, the Office of Personnel Management, and  
6 the Office of Management and Budget, at the time the  
7 budget is submitted by the President to the Congress in  
8 each calendar year, a report on the use of official time  
9 within such agency during the fiscal year last ending be-  
10 fore the date of the report’s submission.

11       “(2) Each such report shall include, with respect to  
12 the fiscal year to which it pertains—

13           “(A) the number of hours of official time that  
14 employees spent on labor organization activities;

15           “(B) the number of employees who used official  
16 time for labor organization activities;

17           “(C) the number of employees who spent 100  
18 percent of their time on labor organization activities;

19           “(D) the dollar value of the official time spent  
20 on labor organization activities;

21           “(E) the dollar value of the office space, equip-  
22 ment, telephone use, and supplies provided to em-  
23 ployees using official time for labor organization ac-  
24 tivities; and

1           “(F) the benefits and disadvantages of using of-  
2           ficial time for labor organization activities.”.
