1 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF LIMITATION ON RECEIPT OF SPECIAL

- 2 PAY BY DENTAL OFFICERS.
- 3 Section 302b(a)(4) of title 37, United States Code,
- 4 is amended by striking "for any 12-month period during
- 5 which the officer is not undergoing dental internship or
- 6 residency training. Such additional special pay shall be

7 paid".
