## A BILL

To provide for an exchange of certain private property in Colorado and certain Federal property in Utah.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PROPERTY EXCHANGE.
- 4 (a) AUTHORITY.—If the owners of the land described
- 5 in section 2(a) convey to the United States all right, title,
- 6 and interest in and to that land, the Secretary of the Inte-
- 7 rior shall, immediately without limitation, convey to those
- 8 owners all right, title, and interest of the United States
- 9 in and to the land described in section 2(b), subject to
- 10 section 3.

1 (b) EXCHANGE OF EQUAL VALUE.—The land authorized to be exchanged under subsection (a) shall be deemed to be of equal value for the purposes of any Federal law 3 or regulation governing exchanges involving Federal land. 5 (c) Relationship to Other Requirements.— Any conveyance of land by the United States under this Act may be made without regard to any provision of Fed-8 eral law that otherwise would require a resource assessment with respect to the conveyance. 10 SEC. 2. PROPERTY DESCRIBED. (a) PRIVATE LAND TO BE CONVEYED.—The land 11 12 authorized to be conveyed to the United States under section 1 is the approximately 2,048 acres of land located in Colorado and generally depicted on the map entitled 14 "\_\_\_\_", dated \_\_\_\_. 15 16 (b) United States Land To Be Conveyed.—The Federal land authorized to be conveyed under section 1 is the approximately 3,400 acres of land located in Utah 18 and generally depicted on the map entitled ", dated 19 20 21 SEC. 3. CONDITION OF CONVEYANCE BY UNITED STATES. 22 As a condition of any conveyance of an interest in land by the United States under this section, the Secretary shall require that—

1	(1) the person to which the interest is conveyed
2	shall convey to the State of Utah, by not later than
3	2 years after the date of the conveyance by the
4	United States, a conservation easement to protect
5	cultural resources and natural resources located on
6	the land, that is required to be administered by the
7	State of Utah Department of Natural Resources Di-
8	vision of Wildlife Resources (or any successor to the
9	conservation functions of that division); and
10	(2) if the person fails to convey a conservation
11	easement in accordance with paragraph (1)—
12	(A) all right, title, and interest conveyed
13	by the United States under this Act shall revert
14	to the United States; and
15	(B) all right, title, and interest conveyed to
16	the United States under this Act shall revert to
17	the person that made such conveyance to the
18	United States.
19	SEC. 4. JURISDICTION OF LAND CONVEYED TO THE UNITED
20	STATES.
21	Land conveyed to the United States pursuant to this
22	Act shall be under the administrative jurisdiction of the
23	Bureau of Land Management.
