A BILL

To make technical corrections in patent law.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Plant Breeders Equity
- 5 Act of 2002".
- 6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENTS TO TITLE 35, UNITED STATES CODE.
- 7 (a) Heading of section 162 of title
- 8 35, United States Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 9 "§ 162. Description, claim, novelty".
- 10 (b) Novelty.—Section 162 of title 35, United States
- 11 Code, is amended by adding at the end the following new
- 12 paragraph:

- 1 "No plant patent application shall be denied, nor
- 2 shall any issued plant patent be invalidated, on the
- 3 grounds that the invention was described in a printed pub-
- 4 lication to which section 102(b) of this title applies, unless
- 5 the invention was described in a printed publication in this
- 6 or a foreign country more than ten years prior to the date
- 7 of the application for patent in the United States.".
- 8 (c) Conforming Amendment.—The item relating
- 9 to section 162 in the table of sections for chapter 15 of
- 10 title 35, United States Code, is amended to read as fol-
- 11 lows:

"162. Description, claim, novelty.".

- 12 (d) Effective Date.—The amendments made by
- 13 this section shall take effect on the date of the enactment
- 14 of this Act and shall apply to any application for a plant
- 15 patent that is filed on and after that date, or is pending
- 16 on that date, and to any patent in force on that date.
