To amend title 38, United States Code, to provide for payment by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs of dependency and indemnity compensation to the surviving spouse of a deceased veteran who for at least one year preceding death had a combination of service-connected disabilities rated totally disabling that included a compensable service-connected cold-weather injury.

1	SECTION 1. DEPENDENCY AND INDEMNITY COMPENSATION
2	FOR SURVIVING SPOUSES OF CERTAIN VET-
3	ERANS WHO INCURRED COMPENSABLE
4	COLD-WEATHER INJURIES WHILE IN SERV-
5	ICE.
6	(a) Disability Rated Totally Disabling for
7	ONE YEAR PRECEDING DEATH.—Section 1318(b) of title
8	38, United States Code, is amended by adding at the end
9	the following new paragraph:
10	"(4) The veteran's last discharge or other re-
11	lease from active duty was before August 13, 1998,
12	and the disability—
13	"(A) was continuously rated totally dis-
14	abling for a period of not less than one year im-
15	mediately preceding death; and
16	"(B) included, as part of a combination of
17	service-connected diseases or injuries considered
18	to form the rating of total disability, a compen-
19	sable cold-weather injury that was determined
20	by the Secretary after August 13, 1998, to be
21	service-connected.".
22	(b) Technical Amendments.—Such section is fur-

24	(1) by striking "if—" in the matter preceding
25	paragraph (1) and inserting "if any of the following
26	applies:";

1	(2) by striking "the" at the beginning of para-
2	graphs (1), (2), and (3) and inserting "The";

4	paragraph (1) and inserting a period; and
5	(4) by striking "; or" at the end of paragraph
6	(2) and inserting a period.
