- 4 This Act may be cited as the "LAX Contour Expan-

- 3 (a) In General.—Notwithstanding any regulation,
- 4 order, agreement, or approval of the Secretary of Trans-
- 5 portation, the standard for soundproofing a residential
- 6 building under section 47502 of title 49, United States
- 7 Code, for Los Angeles International Airport shall be a
- 8 community noise equivalent level of 60 decibels instead of
- 9 65 decibels.
- 10 (b) Definition.—In this section, the term "commu-
- 11 nity noise equivalent level" has the meaning such term has
- 12 under section 150.7 of title 14 of the Code of Federal Reg-
- 13 ulations as in effect on June 1, 2002.
- 14 SEC. 3. HOLD HARMLESS.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sub-
- 16 mission of a noise exposure map under section 47503 of
- 17 title 49, United States Code, to the Secretary of Transpor-
- 18 tation by the operator of Los Angeles International Air-
- 19 port for the purpose of complying with section 1 shall not
- 20 affect the eligibility of a residential building that was eligi-
- 21 ble on June 1, 2002, for noise mitigation assistance under
- 22 chapter 471 of title 49, United States Code.
