A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Agriculture to convey certain real property in the Dixie National Forest in the State of Utah.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. CONVEYANCE OF REAL PROPERTY.

- 2 (a) In General.—As soon as practicable after the 3 date of the enactment of this Act, subject to valid, existing
- 4 rights, the Secretary of Agriculture shall convey to Kirk R.
- 5 Harrison, who owns property in Pinto Valley, Utah, at fair
- 6 market value, all right, title, and interest, including appur-
- 7 tenances, of the United States to—
- 8 (1) the land depicted on the Map as "Purchase
- 9 *A*"; and
- 10 (2) the land depicted on the Map as "Purchase
- B".
- (b) MAP.—
- 13 (1) Definition.—For the purposes of this sec-
- 14 tion, the term "Map" means the map entitled "Ex-
- hibit G" and dated "September 10, 2002".
- 16 (2) On file.—The Map shall be kept on file and
- 17 available for public inspection in the office of the
- 18 Chief of the Forest Service. The Secretary of Agri-
- 19 culture may make technical corrections to the Map.
- 20 (c) Treatment of Proceeds.—All funds received
- 21 pursuant to this Act shall be deposited in the fund estab-
- 22 lished under section 8 of Public Law 90-171 (16 U.S.C.
- 23 484a; commonly known as the "Sisk Act") and shall remain
- 24 available to the Secretary of Agriculture until expended for
- 25 the acquisition of lands and interests in land for inclusion
- 26 in the Dixie National Forest.

1	(d) APPRAISAL.—The Secretary shall determine the
2	fair market value of the property conveyed by subsection
3	(a) by using nationally recognized appraisal standards, in-
4	cluding, to the extent appropriate—
5	(1) the uniform appraisal standards for Federal
6	land acquisitions;
7	(2) the uniform standards of professional ap-
8	praisal practice; and
9	(3) other applicable law.
