- To authorize the Secretary of Agriculture to enter into cooperative agreements and contracts with the Nebraska State Forester to carry out watershed restoration and protection activities on National Forest System land in the State of Nebraska.

 - 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Nebraska National5 Forest Cooperation Act of 2002".

1 SEC. 2. WATERSHED RESTORATION AND PROTECTION AC 2 TIVITIES IN THE STATE OF NEBRASKA.

3 (a) COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS AND CONTRACTS.— The Secretary of Agriculture may enter into a cooperative 4 5 agreement or contract, including a sole source contract, with the Nebraska State Forester, under which the State 6 7 Forester may carry out eligible watershed restoration and 8 protection activities on National Forest System land in the 9 State of Nebraska if similar or complementary activities 10 are being carried out by the State Forester on State or private land that is adjacent to the National Forest Sys-11 tem land. 12

(b) ELIGIBLE ACTIVITIES.—Watershed restoration
and protection activities that are eligible to be carried out
by the Nebraska State Forester under subsection (a) shall
include—

- 17 (1) treatment of insect-infected trees;
- 18 (2) reduction of hazardous fuels; and
- 19 (3) other activities to restore or improve water-20 sheds across ownership boundaries.

(c) AGENCY AGREEMENT.—Except as provided in
subsection (f), a cooperative agreement or contract under
subsection (a) may authorize the Nebraska State Forester
to be an agent of the Secretary for the purpose of carrying
out the watershed restoration or protection activities
under the cooperative agreement or contract.

(d) SUBCONTRACTS AUTHORIZED.—In carrying out
 the watershed restoration or protection activities under
 this section, the Nebraska State Forester may enter into
 subcontracts in accordance with applicable contract proce dures of the State of Nebraska.

6 (e) TIMBER SALES.—Subsections (d) and (g) of sec7 tion 14 of the National Forest Management Act of 1976
8 (16 U.S.C. 472a) shall not apply to watershed restoration
9 and protection activities carried out by the Nebraska State
10 Forester under this section.

11 (f) NO DELEGATION OF DUTIES UNDER NEPA.— 12 With respect to any watershed restoration or protection 13 activity of the Nebraska State Forester carried out or proposed to be carried out under this section, the Secretary 14 15 shall not delegate to the State Forester or to any other employee of the Nebraska Forest Service any of the duties 16 17 of the Secretary under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4321 et seq.). 18

(g) TERMINATION OF AUTHORITY.—The authority of
the Secretary to enter into cooperative agreements or contracts under this section terminates on September 30,
2006.
