## A BILL

- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Self-Employed Health
- 5 Equity Adjustment to Lower Tax Hindrance Act".

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1	SEC. 2. ALLOWANCE OF HEALTH INSURANCE DEDUCTION
2	FOR SELF-EMPLOYED INDIVIDUALS FOR PUR-
3	POSES OF SELF-EMPLOYMENT TAX.
4	(a) In General.—Section 162(l) of the Internal
5	Revenue Code of 1986 (relating to special rules for health
6	insurance costs of self-employed individuals) is amended
7	by striking paragraph (4) (relating to deduction not al-
8	lowed for self-employment tax purposes) and redesignating
9	paragraph (5) as paragraph (4).
10	(b) Effective Date.—The amendment made by
11	this section shall apply to taxable years beginning after
12	December 31, 2002.

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
