A BILL

To establish a moratorium on approval by the Secretary of the Interior of relinquishment of a lease of certain tribal lands in California.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. RESTRICTION ON RELINQUISHMENT OF LEASE.**

4 Prior to January 1, 2005, the Secretary of the Interior shall not approve the relinquishment of any lease entered into for the establishment of a health care facility for the members of 7 Indian tribes or bands in San Diego County, California, unless the Secretary has determined that the relinquishment of such lease has been approved,

- 1 by tribal resolution, by each of the 7 Indian tribes or
- 2 bands.
