A BILL

For the relief of Irina V. Kotlova-Green and her son, Nikita
Kotlov.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. FOR THE RELIEF OF IRINA V. KOTLOVA-GREEN**
4 **AND NIKITA KOTLOV.**

5 (a) PERMANENT RESIDENCE.—Notwithstanding any
6 other provision of law, for purposes of the Immigration
7 and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Irina V.
8 Kotlova-Green and her son, Nikita Kotlov, shall be held
9 and considered to have been lawfully admitted to the
10 United States for permanent residence as of the date of

1 the enactment of this Act upon payment of the required
2 visa fees.

3 (b) REDUCTION IN NUMBER OF AVAILABLE VISAS.—

4 Upon the granting of permanent residence to Irina V.
5 Kotlova-Green and her son Nikita Kotlov as provided in
6 subsection (a), the Secretary of State shall instruct the
7 proper officer to reduce by the appropriate number during
8 the current fiscal year the total number of immigrant visas
9 available to natives of the country of the aliens' birth
10 under section 203(a) of the Immigration and Nationality
11 Act (8 U.S.C. 1153(a)).
