A BILL

To amend the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act by allowing duty-free treatment for certain footwear.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF CERTAIN FOOTWEAR UNDER

CARIBBEAN BASIN ECONOMIC RECOVERY

ACT.

Section 213(b)(3)(A) of the Caribbean Basin Economic Recovery Act (19 U.S.C. 2703(b)(3)(A)) is

amended—

1	(1) in clause (i), by striking "Subject to clause
2	(ii)" and inserting "Subject to clauses (ii) and (iii)"
3	and
4	(2) by adding at the end the following:
5	"(iii) CERTAIN FOOTWEAR.—Notwith-
6	standing paragraph (1)(B) and clause (i)
7	of this subparagraph, footwear provided
8	for in subheading 6403.99.60 of the HTS
9	shall be eligible for the duty-free treatment
10	provided for under this title if—
11	"(I) the article of footwear is the
12	growth, product, or manufacture of a
13	CBTPA beneficiary country; and
14	"(II) the article otherwise meets
15	the requirements of subsection (a), ex-
16	cept that in applying such subsection
17	'CBTPA beneficiary country' shall be
18	substituted for 'beneficiary country'
19	each place it appears.".
