A BILL

To amend the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act of 1968 to ensure public safety officers receive benefits.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LINE OF DUTY.**

4 Section 1204 of title I of the Omnibus Crime Control
5 and Safe Streets Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 3796b) is
6 amended—

7 (1) in paragraph (6) by striking “and” after
8 the semicolon;

9 (2) in paragraph (7), by striking the period and
10 inserting “; and”; and

(3) by adding at the end the following:

“(8) ‘line of duty’ means—

“(A) any action which a public safety officer is obligated or authorized by rule, regulation, condition of employment or service, or law to perform, including those social, ceremonial, or athletic functions to which the officer is assigned, or for which the officer is compensated, by the public agency he serves; and

“(B) any action which an officer or public employee, as described in subparagraph (A), performs that occurs in a jurisdiction other than that of the employing agency but would otherwise be recognized as obligated or authorized by rule, regulation, condition of employment or service, or law to perform if the activity had taken place within the jurisdiction of the employing agency.”.
