- 6 Treasury, officers and agents of the Secret Service are au-
- 7 thorized, at the request of any State or local law enforce-
- 8 ment agency, or at the request of the National Center for
- 9 Missing and Exploited Children, to provide forensic and

- 1 investigative assistance in support of any investigation in-
- 2 volving missing or exploited children.".
