A BILL

To clarify the boundaries of the Plum Island Unit of the Coastal Barrier Resources System.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPLACEMENT OF COASTAL BARRIER RE-
4 SOURCES SYSTEM MAP.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—The map described in subsection
6 (b) is replaced, in the maps depicting the Coastal Barrier
7 Resources System that are referred to in section 4(a) of
8 the Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)),
9 by the map entitled “Plum Tree Island Unit VA-59P,

1 Long Creek Unit VA-60/VA-60P" and dated May 1,
2 2002.

3 (b) DESCRIPTION OF REPLACED MAP.—The map de-
4 scribed in this subsection is the map that—

5 (1) relates to Plum Island Unit VA-59P and
6 Long Creek Unit VA-60/VA-60P located in
7 Poquoson and Hampton, Virginia; and

8 (2) is included in a set of maps entitled 'Coast-
9 al Barrier Resources System", dated October 24,
10 1990, revised on October 23, 1992, and referred to
11 in section 4(a) of the Coastal Barrier Resources Act
12 (16 U.S.C. 3503(a)).

13 **SEC. 2. AVAILABILITY.**

14 The Secretary of the Interior shall keep the replace-
15 ment map referred to in section 1 on file and available
16 for inspection in accordance with section 4(b) of the
17 Coastal Barrier Resources Act (16 U.S.C. 3503(b)).
