  - 7 Section 7116(i) of the Elementary and Secondary
  - 8 Education Act of 1965 (20 U.S.C. 7426(i)) is amended—

4	NATIVE INSTRUCTIONAL PROGRAMS.—In awarding

8	entity because the entity seeks to implement a spe-
9	cial alternative instructional program.";
