## A BILL

To amend the Hate Crime Statistics Act to require the Attorney General to acquire data about crimes that manifest evidence of prejudice based on gender.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

**3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Hate Crime Statistics  
5       Improvement Act of 2001”.

**6 SEC. 2. AMENDMENT TO HATE CRIME STATISTICS ACT.**

7       (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (b)(1) of the first sec-  
8       tion of the Hate Crime Statistics Act (28 U.S.C. 534 note)  
9       is amended—

1 (1) by striking “or” after “sexual orientation,”;

3 (2) by inserting “or gender,” after “ethnicity.”
