Mr. WYNN introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee

A BILL

For the relief of Valentine Nwandu.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OF, OR**
4 **DENIAL OF ADMISSION TO, VALENTINE**
5 **NWANDU.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding section 237(a),
7 and paragraphs (2)(A)(i)(II), (2)(C), (5)(A)(i), (6)(C),
8 and (7)(A)(i)(I) of section 212(a), of the Immigration and
9 Nationality Act, Valentine Nwandu may not be removed
10 from the United States or denied admission to the United
11 States by reason of any criminal offense that is reflected
12 in the records of the Immigration and Naturalization

1 Service of the Department of Justice, or the Visa Office
2 of the Department of State, on the date of the enactment
3 of this Act.

4 (b) RESCISSION OF OUTSTANDING ORDER OF RE-
5 MOVAL.—The Attorney General shall rescind any out-
6 standing order of removal, or any finding of inadmis-
7 sibility, that has been entered against Valentine Nwandu
8 by reason of any offense described in subsection (a). Any
9 such offense shall not be taken into account in deter-
10 mining whether Valentine Nwandu is eligible to receive a
11 visa or whether the status of Valentine Nwandu may be
12 adjusted to that of an alien lawfully admitted to the
13 United States for permanent residence.

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
