## A BILL

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. APPLICATION OF COUNTERVAILING DUTIES TO**  
4       **NONMARKET ECONOMY COUNTRIES.**

5       Section 701(a)(1) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19  
6       U.S.C. 1671(a)(1)) is amended by inserting “(including  
7       a nonmarket economy country)” after “country” each  
8       place it appears.

1 **SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

2       The amendments made by section 1 apply to sub-  
3 sides provided on or after the date of the enactment of  
4 this Act.
