5	cial Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1382a(b)) is amended—
6	(1) by striking "and" at the end of paragraph

9	graph (22) and inserting "; and"; and
10	(3) by adding at the end the following:
11	"(23) any annuity paid by a State to the indi-
12	vidual (or such spouse) on the basis of the individual

15	(b) Resource Disregard.—Section 1613(a) of

21	(3) by inserting after paragraph (13) the fol-
