A BILL

For the relief of Donna Christine Fargo.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR INELIGIBILITY FOR**
4 **ADMISSION AND REMOVAL FOR DONNA**
5 **CHRISTINE FARGO.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 212(a)
7 and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act,
8 Donna Christine Fargo may not be considered to be within
9 a class of aliens ineligible to be admitted to the United
10 States, or a class of deportable aliens, at any time on or
11 after the date of the enactment of this Act by reason of—

1 (1) her convictions on August 7, 1984, for mak-
2 ing false statements to a government office in order
3 to obtain unemployment benefits; or

4 (2) her concealment of these convictions from
5 officers of the Immigration and Naturalization Serv-
6 ice on April 9, 1997.

7 (b) APPLICATION TO KNOWN GROUNDS.—Subsection
8 (a) shall apply only to grounds for ineligibility for admis-
9 sion, and grounds for removal, reflected in the records of
10 the Immigration and Naturalization Service of the Depart-
11 ment of Justice, or the Visa Office of the Department of
12 State, on the date of the enactment of this Act.
