A BILL

To amend the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act to provide for renewals of grants for permanent housing under the supportive housing program and for shelter plus care assistance to be funded through section 8 rental assistance amounts made available under the Housing Certificate Fund of the Department of Housing and Urban Development.

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Homeless Prevention
3 Permanent Housing Renewal Act of 2001”.

4 **SEC. 2. RENEWAL OF PERMANENT HOUSING GRANTS AND**
5 **SHELTER PLUS CARE GRANTS UNDER HOUS-**
6 **ING CERTIFICATE FUND.**

7 (a) SUPPORTIVE HOUSING PROGRAM PERMANENT
8 HOUSING GRANT RENEWALS.—Section 429 of the McKin-
9 ney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act (42 U.S.C. 11389) is
10 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
11 section:

12 “(d) PERMANENT HOUSING GRANT RENEWALS.—
13 For fiscal year 2002 and each fiscal year thereafter, there
14 are authorized to be appropriated, from any amounts ap-
15 propriated under the Housing Certificate Fund account
16 of the Department of Housing and Urban Development
17 for assistance under section 8 of the United States Hous-
18 ing Act of 1937, such sums as may be necessary for re-
19 newing expiring grants under this subtitle for permanent
20 housing for homeless persons with disabilities.”.

21 (b) SHELTER PLUS CARE GRANT RENEWALS.—Sec-
22 tion 463 of the McKinney-Vento Homeless Assistance Act
23 (42 U.S.C. 11403h) is amended by adding at the end the
24 following new subsection:

25 “(c) GRANT RENEWALS.—For fiscal year 2002 and
26 each fiscal year thereafter, there are authorized to be ap-

1 appropriated, from any amounts appropriated under the
2 Housing Certificate Fund account of the Department of
3 Housing and Urban Development for assistance under sec-
4 tion 8 of the United States Housing Act of 1937, such
5 sums as may be necessary for renewing expiring grants
6 under this subtitle.”.
