A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to exempt amounts owed for prescription drugs and medical supplies dispensed by Department of Veterans Affairs pharmacies from otherwise applicable interest charges and administrative cost charges imposed on indebtedness to the United States resulting from the provision of medical care or services by the Department of Veterans Affairs.

1 **SECTION 1. EXEMPTION OF AMOUNTS OWED FOR PRE-**
2 **SCRIPTION DRUGS AND MEDICAL SUPPLIES**
3 **DISPENSED BY DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS**
4 **AFFAIRS PHARMACIES FROM OTHERWISE AP-**
5 **PLICABLE INTEREST CHARGES AND ADMINIS-**
6 **TRATIVE COST CHARGES.**

7 (a) EXEMPTION.—Section 5315(a)(2) of title 38,
8 United States Code, is amended by inserting “(other than
9 an indebtedness resulting from the provision of prescrip-
10 tion drugs or medical supplies by a Department phar-
11 macy)” after “of this title”.

12 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
13 subsection (a) shall take effect on the first day of the first
14 month beginning on or after the date of the enactment
15 of this Act and shall apply with respect to charges for
16 months beginning on or after that date, regardless of when
17 an indebtedness was incurred.

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
