A BILL

To provide compensation for injury and property damages suffered by persons as a result of the bombing attack by the United States on August 20, 1998, in Khartoum, Sudan, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. PAYMENT.
- 4 The Secretary of the Treasury shall pay, from
- 5 amounts in the Treasury not otherwise appropriated, such
- 6 sum as necessary up to a total amount of \$50,000,000
- 7 in settlement of claims by persons suffering injury or
- 8 property loss as a result of the missile attack in Khar-

- 1 toum, Sudan, on August 20, 1998, by the Armed Forces
- 2 of the United States. Such payments shall be in full satis-
- 3 faction of these claims.
- 4 SEC. 2. RELATION OF PAYMENT TO REFERRAL TO COURT
- 5 OF CLAIMS.
- 6 The Secretary of the Treasury shall not pay any
- 7 claim filed against the United States or any agency thereof
- 8 later than 60 days after reference of this bill to the Court
- 9 of Claims pursuant to section 1492 of title 28, United
- 10 States Code.

11 SEC. 3. LIMITATION ON ATTORNEYS' FEES.

- No part of the amounts appropriated under section
- 13 1 in excess of 10 percent thereof shall be paid or delivered
- 14 to or received by any agent or attorney on account of serv-
- 15 ices rendered in connection with the claim referred to in
- 16 section 1, and the same shall be unlawful, any contract
- 17 to the contrary notwithstanding. Any person violating the
- 18 provisions of this section shall be fined not more than
- 19 \$1,000.
