- 3 SECTION 1. ESTABLISHMENT OF ELECTION DAY IN PRESI-
- 4 DENTIAL ELECTION YEARS AS A LEGAL PUB-
- 5 LIC HOLIDAY.
- 6 Section 6103(a) of title 5, United States Code, is
- 7 amended by inserting after the item relating to Columbus
- 8 Day the following new item:

1	"Presidential Election Day, the Tuesday next
2	after the first Monday in November in 2004 and
3	each fourth year thereafter.".
4	SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS REGARDING TREATMENT OF
5	DAY BY PRIVATE EMPLOYERS.
6	It is the sense of Congress that private employers in
7	the United States should give their employees a day off
8	on the Tuesday next after the first Monday in November
9	in 2004 and each fourth year thereafter to enable the em-
10	ployees to cast votes in the Presidential and other elections
11	held on that day.
