# RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of motions to suspend the rules.

1       *Resolved*, That it shall be in order at any time on  
2 the legislative day of Wednesday, June 27, 2001, for the  
3 Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the  
4 rules relating to the following measures:

5           (1) The resolution (H. Res. 172) honoring John  
6 J. Downing, Brian Fahey, and Harry Ford, who lost  
7 their lives in the course of duty as firefighters.

8           (2) The bill (H.R. 2133) to establish a commis-  
9 sion for the purpose of encouraging and providing

1 for the commemoration of the 50th anniversary of  
2 the Supreme Court decision in Brown v. Board of  
3 Education.

4 (3) The bill (S. 757) to designate the Federal  
5 building and United States courthouse located at  
6 504 West Hamilton Street in Allentown, Pennsyl-  
7 vania, as the “Edward N. Cahn Federal Building  
8 and United States Courthouse”.

9 (4) The bill (H.R. 691) to extend the authoriza-  
10 tion of funding for child passenger protection edu-  
11 cation grants through fiscal year 2003.
