Mr. CUNNINGHAM submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 218) to amend title 18, United States Code, to exempt qualified current and former law enforcement officers from State laws prohibiting the carrying of concealed handguns.

1 *Resolved*, That immediately upon the adoption of this
2 resolution the House shall resolve into the Committee of
3 the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-
4 ation of the bill (H.R. 218) to amend title 18, United
5 States Code, to exempt qualified current and former law
6 enforcement officers from State laws prohibiting the car-
7 rying of concealed handguns. The first reading of the bill
8 shall be dispensed with and all points of order against the

1 bill and its consideration are waived. General debate shall
2 be confined to the bill and shall not exceed one hour, to
3 be equally divided and controlled by Mr. Cunningham of
4 California and a Member opposed thereto. After general
5 debate, the bill shall be considered as having been read
6 for amendment under the five-minute rule. At the conclu-
7 sion of the consideration of the bill for amendment, the
8 Committee shall rise and report the bill to the House with
9 such amendments as may have been adopted. The previous
10 question shall be considered as ordered on the bill and
11 amendments thereto to final passage without intervening
12 motion, except one motion to recommit with or without
13 instructions. If the Committee of the Whole rises and re-
14 ports that it has come to no resolution on the bill, then
15 on the next legislative day the House shall, immediately
16 after the third daily order of business under clause 1 of
17 rule XIV, resolve into the Committee of the Whole for fur-
18 ther consideration of the bill.
