## RESOLUTION

Expressing the support of the House of Representatives for President Bush's tax cut for families and small businesses as embodied in Public Law 107-16 and opposing any effort to delay implementation of this tax cut.

Whereas Public Law 107-16 eliminated the death tax;

Whereas Public Law 107-16 eliminated the marriage penalty;

Whereas Public Law 107-16 reduced marginal tax rates for the first time in 20 years;

Whereas Public Law 107-16 lowered the tax burden of millions of middle class families;

Whereas Public Law 107-16 reduced taxes levied on small business men and women;

Whereas raising taxes would erode investor confidence;

Whereas raising taxes would mean taking money from American families; and

Whereas raising taxes would further hurt our economy: Now, therefore, be it

1        *Resolved*,

2    **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

3        This resolution may be cited as the “Save America’s  
4 Tax Cut Resolution”.

5    **SEC. 2. SENSE OF CONGRESS.**

6        It is the sense of the House of Representatives that—

7                (1) the House of Representatives supports  
8        President Bush’s Tax Cut for families and small  
9        business, and

10                (2) the House of Representatives is opposed to  
11        repealing or delaying implementation of Public Law  
12        107–16.
