RESOLUTION

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to require a three-fifths vote to pass any measure the enactment of which would result in a deficit in the unified budget of the United States for any fiscal year.

- 1 Resolved, That rule XXI of the Rules of the House
- 2 of Representatives is amended by adding at the end the
- 3 following new clause:
- 4 "7. (a) A bill or joint resolution, amendment, or con-
- 5 ference report the enactment of which would result in a
- 6 deficit in the unified budget of the United States for any
- 7 fiscal year may not be considered as passed or agreed to

- 1 unless so determined by a vote of not less than three-fifths
- 2 of the Members voting, a quorum being present.
- 3 "(b) For purposes of this clause, the levels of outlays
- 4 and revenues for a fiscal year shall be determined on the
- 5 basis of estimates made by the Committee on the Budget.
- 6 "(c) This clause is waived while a declaration of war
- 7 is in effect or during a military conflict.".
