Mr. DREIER (for himself and Mr. MOAKLEY) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

RESOLUTION

Providing amounts for the expenses of the Committee on Rules in the One Hundred Seventh Congress.

1 *Resolved,*

2 **SECTION 1. AMOUNTS FOR COMMITTEE EXPENSES.**

3 For the expenses of the Committee on Rules (here-
4 after in this resolution referred to as the “Committee”),
5 including the expenses of all staff salaries, there shall be
6 paid, out of the applicable accounts of the House of Rep-
7 resentatives for committee salaries and expenses, not more
8 than \$5,370,773 for the One Hundred Seventh Congress.

9 **SEC. 2. SESSION LIMITATIONS.**

10 Of the amount specified in section 1—

1 (1) not more than \$2,644,509 shall be available
2 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
3 noon on January 3, 2001, and ending immediately
4 before noon on January 3, 2002; and

5 (2) not more than \$2,726,264 shall be available
6 for expenses incurred during the period beginning at
7 noon on January 3, 2002, and ending immediately
8 before noon on January 3, 2003.

9 **SEC. 3. VOUCHERS.**

10 Payments under this resolution shall be made on
11 vouchers authorized by the Committee, signed by the
12 Chairman of the Committee, and approved in the manner
13 directed by the Committee on House Administration.

14 **SEC. 4. REGULATIONS.**

15 Amounts made available under this resolution shall
16 be expended in accordance with regulations prescribed by
17 the Committee on House Administration.
