Mr. DIAZ-BALART, from the Committee on Rules, reported the following resolution; which was referred to the House Calendar and ordered to be printed

## RESOLUTION

Providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 3994) to authorize economic and democratic development assistance for Afghanistan and to authorize military assistance for Afghanistan and certain other foreign countries.

1       *Resolved*, That at any time after the adoption of this  
2 resolution the Speaker may, pursuant to clause 2(b) of  
3 rule XVIII, declare the House resolved into the Committee  
4 of the Whole House on the state of the Union for consider-  
5 ation of the bill (H.R. 3994) to authorize economic and

1 democratic development assistance for Afghanistan and to  
2 authorize military assistance for Afghanistan and certain  
3 other foreign countries. The first reading of the bill shall  
4 be dispensed with. General debate shall be confined to the  
5 bill and shall not exceed one hour equally divided and con-  
6 trolled by the chairman and ranking minority member of  
7 the Committee on International Relations. After general  
8 debate the bill shall be considered for amendment under  
9 the five-minute rule. It shall be in order to consider as  
10 an original bill for the purpose of amendment under the  
11 five-minute rule the amendment in the nature of a sub-  
12 stitute recommended by the Committee on International  
13 Relations now printed in the bill. The committee amend-  
14 ment in the nature of a substitute shall be considered by  
15 title rather than by section. Each title shall be considered  
16 as read. During consideration of the bill for amendment,  
17 the Chairman of the Committee of the Whole may accord  
18 priority in recognition on the basis of whether the Member  
19 offering an amendment has caused it to be printed in the  
20 portion of the Congressional Record designated for that  
21 purpose in clause 8 of rule XVIII. Amendments so printed  
22 shall be considered as read. At the conclusion of consider-  
23 ation of the bill for amendment the Committee shall rise  
24 and report the bill to the House with such amendments  
25 as may have been adopted. Any Member may demand a

1 separate vote in the House on any amendment adopted  
2 in the Committee of the Whole to the bill or to the com-  
3 mittee amendment in the nature of a substitute. The pre-  
4 vious question shall be considered as ordered on the bill  
5 and amendments thereto to final passage without inter-  
6 vening motion except one motion to recommit with or  
7 without instructions.
