Mr. Sullivan (for himself, Mr. Otter, Mr. Brady of Texas, Mr. Ryun of Kansas, and Mr. Pombo) submitted the following resolution; which was referred to the Committee on Rules

## **RESOLUTION**

Amending the Rules of the House of Representatives to establish a discretionary spending ledger and a mandatory spending ledger.

- 1 Resolved, The Rules of the House of Representatives
- 2 are amended by redesignating rule XXVII as rule XXIX
- 3 and by inserting after rule XXVI the following new rules:
- 4 "RULE XXVII
- 5 "DISCRETIONARY SPENDING LEDGER.
- 6 "1. (a) The chairman of the Committee on the Budg-
- 7 et shall maintain a ledger to be known as the 'Discre-
- 8 tionary Spending Ledger'. The Ledger shall be divided
- 9 into entries corresponding to the subcommittees of the

- 1 Committee on Appropriations and each entry shall consist
- 2 of the 'Deficit Reduction Safeguard Balance'.
- 3 "(b) Each entry shall consist only of amounts cred-
- 4 ited to it under paragraph (c). No entry of a negative
- 5 amount shall be made.
- 6 "(c) Whenever a Member offers an amendment to an
- 7 appropriation bill to reduce new budget authority in any
- 8 account, that Member may state the portion of such reduc-
- 9 tion that shall be—
- 10 "(1) credited to the Deficit Reduction Safe-
- 11 guard Balance; or
- "(2) used to offset an increase in new budget
- authority in any other account;
- 14 "(3) allowed to remain within the applicable
- section 302(b) suballocation.
- 16 If no such statement is made, the amount of reduction
- 17 in new budget authority resulting from the amendment
- 18 shall be credited to the Deficit Reduction Safeguard Bal-
- 19 ance, as applicable, if the amendment is agreed to.
- 20 "2. (a) Except as provided by paragraph (b), the
- 21 chairman of the Committee on the Budget shall, upon the
- 22 engrossment of any appropriation bill by the House of
- 23 Representatives, credit to the entry balance amounts of
- 24 new budget authority and outlays equal to the net
- 25 amounts of reductions in new budget authority and in out-

- 1 lays resulting from amendments agreed to by the House
- 2 to that bill.
- 3 "(b) When computing the net amounts of reductions
- 4 in new budget authority and in outlays resulting from
- 5 amendments agreed to by the House to an appropriation
- 6 bill, the chairman of the Committee on the Budget shall
- 7 only count those portions of such amendments agreed to
- 8 that were so designated by the Members offering such
- 9 amendments as amounts to be credited to the Deficit Re-
- 10 duction Safeguard Balance, or that fall within the last
- 11 sentence of clause 1.
- 12 "3. The chairman of the Committee on the Budget
- 13 shall maintain a running tally of the amendments adopted
- 14 reflecting increases and decreases of budget authority in
- 15 the bill as reported. This tally shall be available to Mem-
- 16 bers during consideration of any appropriation bill by the
- 17 House.
- 18 "4. (a) For purposes of enforcing section 302(a) of
- 19 the Congressional Budget Act of 1974, upon the engross-
- 20 ment of any appropriation bill by the House, the amount
- 21 of budget authority and outlays calculated pursuant to
- 22 clause 2(b) shall be counted against the 302(a) allocation
- 23 provided to the Committee on Appropriations as if the
- 24 amount calculated pursuant to such clause was included
- 25 in the bill just engrossed.

- 1 "(b) For purposes of enforcing section 302(b) of the
- 2 Congressional Budget Act of 1974, upon the engrossment
- 3 of any appropriation bill by the House, the 302(b) alloca-
- 4 tion provided to the subcommittee for the bill just en-
- 5 grossed shall be deemed to have been reduced by the
- 6 amount of budget authority and outlays calculated, pursu-
- 7 ant to clause 2(b).
- 8 "5. As used in this rule, the term 'appropriation bill'
- 9 means any general or special appropriation bill, and any
- 10 bill or joint resolution making supplemental, deficiency, or
- 11 continuing appropriations through the end of a fiscal year.
- 12 "6. For purposes of enforcing this rule during the
- 13 second session of this Congress and pending the adoption
- 14 of a concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year
- 15 2003, the provisions of House Concurrent Resolution 353,
- 16 as passed the House, shall have force and effect in the
- 17 House as though Congress has adopted such concurrent
- 18 resolution.
- 19 "MANDATORY SPENDING LEDGER.
- 20 "1. (a) The chairman of the Committee on the Budg-
- 21 et shall maintain a ledger to be known as the 'Mandatory
- 22 Spending Ledger'. The Ledger shall be divided into entries
- 23 corresponding to the House committees that received allo-
- 24 cations under section 302(a) of the Congressional Budget
- 25 Act of 1974 in the most recently adopted concurrent reso-

- 1 lution on the budget, except that it shall not include the
- 2 Committee on Appropriations and each entry shall consist
- 3 of the 'First Year Deficit Reduction Safeguard Balance'
- 4 and the 'Five Year Deficit Reduction Safeguard Balance'.
- 5 "(b) Each entry shall consist only of amounts cred-
- 6 ited to it under paragraph (c). No entry of a negative
- 7 amount shall be made.
- 8 "(c) Whenever a Member offers an amendment to a
- 9 bill that reduces the amount of mandatory budget author-
- 10 ity provided either under current law or proposed to be
- 11 provided by the bill under consideration, that Member may
- 12 state the portion of such reduction achieved in the first
- 13 year covered by the most recently adopted concurrent reso-
- 14 lution on the budget and in addition the portion of such
- 15 reduction achieved in the first five years covered by the
- 16 most recently adopted concurrent resolution on the budget
- 17 that shall be—
- 18 "(1) credited to the First Year Deficit Reduc-
- 19 tion Safeguard Balance and the Five Year Deficit
- 20 Reduction Safeguard Balance; or
- 21 "(2) used to offset an increase in other new
- budget authority;
- "(3) allowed to remain within the applicable
- section 302(a) allocation.

- 1 If no such statement is made, the amount of reduction
- 2 in new budget authority resulting from the amendment
- 3 shall be credited to the First Year Deficit Reduction Safe-
- 4 guard Balance and the Five Year Deficit Reduction Safe-
- 5 guard Balance, as applicable, if the amendment is agreed
- 6 to.
- 7 "2. (a) Except as provided by paragraph (b), the
- 8 chairman of the Committee on the Budget shall, upon the
- 9 engrossment of any bill, other than an appropriation bill,
- 10 by the House, credit to the applicable entry balances
- 11 amounts of new budget authority and outlays equal to the
- 12 net amounts of reductions in budget authority and in out-
- 13 lays resulting from amendments agreed to by the House
- 14 to that bill.
- 15 "(b) When computing the net amounts of reductions
- 16 in budget authority and in outlays resulting from amend-
- 17 ments agreed to by the House to a bill, the chairman of
- 18 the Committee on the Budget shall only count those por-
- 19 tions of such amendments agreed to that were so des-
- 20 ignated by the Members offering such amendments as
- 21 amounts to be credited to the First Year Deficit Reduction
- 22 Safeguard Balance and the Five Year Deficit Reduction
- 23 Safeguard Balance, or that fall within the last sentence
- 24 of clause 1.

- 1 "3. The chairman of the Committee on the Budget
- 2 shall maintain a running tally of the amendments adopted
- 3 reflecting increases and decreases of budget authority in
- 4 the bill as reported. This tally shall be available to Mem-
- 5 bers during consideration of any bill by the House.
- 6 "4. For the purposes of enforcing section 302(a) of
- 7 the Congressional Budget Act of 1974, upon the engross-
- 8 ment of any bill, other than an appropriation bill, by the
- 9 House, the amount of budget authority and outlays cal-
- 10 culated pursuant to paragraph 2(b) shall be counted
- 11 against the 302(a) allocation provided to the applicable
- 12 committee or committees which reported the bill as if the
- 13 amount calculated pursuant to clause 2(b) was included
- 14 in the bill just engrossed.
- 15 "5. As used in this rule, the term 'appropriation bill'
- 16 means any general or special appropriation bill, and any
- 17 bill or joint resolution making supplemental, deficiency, or
- 18 continuing appropriations through the end of a fiscal year.
- 19 "6. For purposes of enforcing this rule during the
- 20 second session of this Congress and pending the adoption
- 21 of a concurrent resolution on the budget for fiscal year
- 22 2003, the provisions of House Concurrent Resolution 353,
- 23 as passed the House, shall have force and effect in the

- 1 House as though Congress has adopted such concurrent
- 2 resolution.".
