Mrs. HUTCHISON (for herself, Mr. INOUE, Mr. HUTCHINSON, and Mr. STEVENS) introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Armed Services

## A BILL

To amend title 10, United States Code, to authorize disability retirement to be granted posthumously for members of the Armed Forces who die in the line of duty while on active duty, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. POSTHUMOUS DISABILITY RETIREMENT FOR**  
 2 **MEMBERS OF THE ARMED FORCES WHO DIE**  
 3 **IN THE LINE OF DUTY WHILE ON ACTIVE**  
 4 **DUTY.**

5 (a) **AUTHORITY.**—Chapter 61 of title 10, United  
 6 States Code, is amended by adding at the end the fol-  
 7 lowing new section:

8 **“§ 1222. Posthumous retirement: retroactive effective**  
 9 **date; related elections**

10 “(a) **AUTHORITY.**—Upon a determination by the Sec-  
 11 retary concerned that it is advantageous for the survivors  
 12 of a member of the armed forces who dies in the line of  
 13 duty while on active duty, the Secretary concerned may—

14 “(1) posthumously retire the member under  
 15 section 1201 of this title effective immediately before  
 16 the member’s death; and

17 “(2) make for the deceased member any elec-  
 18 tion with respect to survivor benefits under laws re-  
 19 ferred to in subsection (c) that the deceased member  
 20 would have been entitled to make upon being retired  
 21 under that section.

22 “(b) **CONSTRUCTION WITH SECTION 1201 REQUIRE-**  
 23 **MENTS.**—Nothing in this section modifies the require-  
 24 ments set forth in section 1201 of this title regarding de-  
 25 terminations or eligibility.

1       “(c) ADMINISTRATION OF BENEFITS LAWS.—A re-  
 2       tirement and election under subsection (a) shall be effec-  
 3       tive for the purposes of laws administered by the Secretary  
 4       of Defense or any Secretary concerned and laws adminis-  
 5       tered by the Secretary of Veterans Affairs.

6       “(d) NONREVIEWABILITY OF DETERMINATIONS.—A  
 7       determination or election made by a Secretary concerned  
 8       under subsection (a) is not subject to judicial review.”.

9       (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections  
 10      at the beginning of such chapter is amended by adding  
 11      at the end the following new item:

“1222. Posthumous retirement: retroactive effective date; related elections.”.

12      **SEC. 2. SURVIVOR BENEFIT PLAN.**

13      (a) SURVIVING SPOUSE ANNUITY.—Section 1448(d)  
 14      of title 10, United States Code, is amended by striking  
 15      paragraph (1) and inserting the following:

16               “(1) SURVIVING SPOUSE ANNUITY.—The Sec-  
 17      retary concerned shall pay an annuity under this  
 18      subchapter to the surviving spouse of a member  
 19      who—

20                       “(A) dies in the line of duty while on ac-  
 21                       tive duty after—

22                               “(i) becoming eligible to receive re-  
 23                               tired pay;

1 “(ii) qualifying for retired pay except  
 2 that the member has not applied for or  
 3 been granted that pay; or

4 “(iii) completing 20 years of active  
 5 service but before the member is eligible to  
 6 retire as a commissioned officer because  
 7 the member has not completed 10 years of  
 8 active commissioned service; or

9 “(B) dies in the line of duty while on ac-  
 10 tive duty and is posthumously retired under  
 11 section 1201 of this title pursuant to section  
 12 1222 of this title.”.

13 (b) DEPENDENT CHILD ANNUITY.—Paragraph (2)  
 14 of such section is amended by striking “or if the member’s  
 15 surviving spouse subsequently dies” and inserting “or if  
 16 the payment of an annuity to the member’s surviving  
 17 spouse under that paragraph subsequently terminates”.

18 (c) COMPUTATION OF SURVIVOR ANNUITY.—Section  
 19 1451(c) of title 10, United States Code, is amended by  
 20 adding at the end the following new paragraph:

21 “(5) SERVICE MEMBERS POSTHUMOUSLY RE-  
 22 TIRED.—In the case of an annuity provided under  
 23 section 1448(d)(1)(B) of this title, the retired pay to  
 24 which the member would have been entitled when  
 25 the member died shall be determined for purposes of

1 paragraph (1) based upon the retired pay base com-  
2 puted for the member under section 1406(b) or  
3 1407 of this title as if the member had been retired  
4 under section 1201 of this title on the date of the  
5 member's death.”.

6 (d) CONFORMING AMENDMENT.—Section 1451(c)(3)  
7 of such title is amended by striking “section  
8 1448(d)(1)(B) or 1448(d)(1)(C)” and inserting “clause  
9 (ii) or (iii) of section 1448(d)(1)(A)”.

10 **SEC. 3. EFFECT DATE AND APPLICABILITY.**

11 This Act and the amendments made by this Act shall  
12 take effect on the date of the enactment of this Act and  
13 shall apply with respect to deaths of members of the  
14 Armed Forces occurring on or after that date.
