A BILL

To authorize additional funding for Members of the Senate which may be used by a Member for mailings to provide notice of town meetings.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. MAILINGS FOR TOWN MEETINGS FOR SEN-
4 ATORS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—There are authorized to be appro-
6 priated \$3,000,000 for each of the fiscal years 2002
7 through 2006 for mailings of postal patron postcards by
8 Members of the Senate for the purpose of providing notice
9 of a town meeting by a Member in a county (or equivalent
10 unit of local government) with a population of less than

1 50,000 that the Member will personally attend to be allot-
2 ted as requested.

3 (b) LIMITATION.—Any amount allocated to a Mem-
4 ber for a mailing under this section shall not exceed 50
5 percent of the cost of the mailing and the remaining costs
6 shall be paid by the Member from other funds available
7 to the Member.
