## A BILL

To amend the Poison Prevention Packaging Act to authorize the Consumer Product Safety Commission to require child-proof caps for portable gasoline containers.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This act may be cited as the "Children's Gasoline
- 5 Burn Prevention Act".
- 6 SEC. 2. CHILD-PROOF CAPS FOR GASOLINE CONTAINERS.
- 7 Section 2(3) of the Poison Prevention Packaging Act
- 8 (15 U.S.C. 1471(3)) is amended—

1	(1) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) and
2	(B) as clauses (i) and (ii), respectively;
3	(2) by inserting "(A)" after "(3)"; and
4	(3) by adding at the end the following new sub-
5	paragraph:
6	"(B) Such term includes a portable gasoline
7	container.".
