Mr. INHOFE introduced the following bill; which was read twice and referred to the Committee on Commerce, Science, and Transportation

A BILL

To require a report on any air space restrictions put in place as a result of the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks that remain in place.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. REPORT ON NATIONAL AIR SPACE RESTRI-
4 TIONS PUT IN PLACE AFTER TERRORIST AT-
5 TACKS THAT REMAIN IN PLACE.**

6 (a) REPORT.—On the date of the enactment of this
7 Act, the President shall submit to the committees of Con-
8 gress specified in subsection (b) a report containing—

9 (1) a description of each restriction, if any, on
10 the use of national airspace put in place as a result

1 of the September 11, 2001, terrorist attacks that re-
2 mains in place as of the date of the enactment of
3 this Act; and

4 (2) a justification for such restriction remaining
5 in place.

6 (b) COMMITTEES OF CONGRESS.—The committees of
7 Congress specified in this subsection are the following:

8 (1) The Select Committee on Intelligence of the
9 Senate.

10 (2) The Permanent Select Committee on Intel-
11 ligence of the House of Representatives.
