106–70, Public Law 107–8, and Public Law 107–17, is 2 amended— (1) by striking "October 1, 2001" each place it 3 appears and inserting "April 1, 2002"; and 4 (2) in subsection (a)— 5 (A) by striking "May 31, 2001" and in-6 serting "September 30, 2001"; and 7 (B) by striking "June 1, 2001" and insert-8 ing "October 1, 2001". 9 10 SEC. 2. EFFECTIVE DATE. 11 The amendments made by section 1 shall be deemed to have taken effect on October 1, 2001.
