## A BILL

To suspend temporarily the duty on certain steam turbines  
and generators for power generation.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SUSPENSION OF DUTY ON CERTAIN STEAM**

4 **TURBINES AND GENERATORS.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of  
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is  
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following  
8 new headings:

“	9902.84.06	Steam turbines for power generation exceeding 40 MW, other than stationary steam turbines (provided for in subheading 8406.81.10) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	”.
	9902.84.08	AC generators for power generation exceeding 10,000 kVA (provided for in subheading 8501.64.00) .....	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2005	

1           (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from  
3 warehouse for consumption, after the date that is 15 days  
4 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
