## A BILL

To amend the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Relief Act of 1940 to provide that duty of the National Guard mobilized by a State in support of Operation Enduring Freedom or otherwise at the request of the President shall qualify as military service under that Act.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

1 **SECTION 1. TREATMENT OF DUTY OF NATIONAL GUARD**  
 2 **MOBILIZED BY STATES FOR OPERATION EN-**  
 3 **DURING FREEDOM AS MILITARY SERVICE**  
 4 **UNDER SOLDIERS' AND SAILORS' CIVIL RE-**  
 5 **LIEF ACT OF 1940.**

6 Section 101(1) of the Soldiers' and Sailors' Civil Re-  
 7 lief Act of 1940 (50 U.S.C. App. 511(1)) is amended—

8 (1) in the first sentence—

9 (A) by striking “and all” and inserting  
 10 “all”; and

11 (B) by inserting before the period the fol-  
 12 lowing: “, and all members of the National  
 13 Guard on service described in the following sen-  
 14 tence”; and

15 (2) in the second sentence, by inserting before  
 16 the period the following: “, and shall include service  
 17 of the National Guard, pursuant to a call or order  
 18 to duty by the chief executive officer of a State, in  
 19 support of Operation Enduring Freedom or other-  
 20 wise at the request of the President”.
