## A BILL

To amend the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act to ensure the continuity of medical care following a major disaster by making private forprofit medical facilities eligible for Federal disaster assistance.

12	term care facility' means—
13	"(A) any skilled nursing facility (as de-
14	fined in section 1819(a) of the Social Security
15	Act (42 U.S.C. 1395i-3(a));
16	"(B) any nursing facility (as defined in
17	section 1919(a) of that Act (42 U.S.C.
18	1396r(a)); and
19	"(C) any other long-term care facility,
20	such as an intermediate care facility for the
21	mentally retarded.".
