A BILL

To amend title 23, United States Code, to permit States to place supplemental guide signs relating to veterans' cemeteries on Federal-aid highways.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HIGHWAY SIGNS RELATING TO VETERANS'**
4 **CEMETERIES.**

5 Section 109(d) of title 23, United States Code, is
6 amended—

7 (1) by striking “(d) On” and inserting the fol-
8 lowing:

9 “(d) SIGNS, MARKINGS, AND SIGNALS.—

1 “(1) IN GENERAL.—Subject to paragraph (2),
2 on”; and

3 (2) by adding at the end the following:

4 “(2) VETERANS’ CEMETERIES.—Notwith-
5 standing the terms of any agreement entered into by
6 the Secretary and a State under this subsection or
7 section 402(a) before, on, or after the date of enact-
8 ment of this paragraph, a veterans’ cemetery shall
9 be treated as a site for which a supplemental guide
10 sign may be placed on any Federal-aid highway.”.
