To amend title XIX of the Social Security Act to include medical assistance furnished through an urban Indian health program operated by an urban Indian organization pursuant to a grant or contract with the Indian Health Service under title V of the Indian Health Care Improvement Act in the 100 percent Federal medical assistance percentage applicable to the Indian Health Service.

1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Urban Indian Health
3 Medicaid Amendments Act of 2001”.

4 **SEC. 2. INCLUSION OF MEDICAL ASSISTANCE FURNISHED**
5 **THROUGH AN URBAN INDIAN HEALTH PRO-**
6 **GRAM IN 100 PERCENT FMAP.**

7 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The third sentence of section
8 1905(b) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. 1396d(b))
9 is amended—

10 (1) by inserting “or program” after “facility”;
11 (2) by striking “or by” and inserting “, by”;

12 and

13 (3) by inserting “, or by an urban Indian orga-
14 nization pursuant to a grant or contract with the In-
15 dian Health Service under title V of the Indian
16 Health Care Improvement Act” before the period.

17 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
18 subsection (a) take effect on October 1, 2002.
