3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF TODD BEAMER POST OFFICE**
4 **BUILDING.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 65 North Main Street in
7 Cranbury, New Jersey, shall be known and designated as
8 the “Todd Beamer Post Office Building”.

1 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
2 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
3 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
4 be deemed to be a reference to the Todd Beamer Post
5 Office Building.
