A BILL

To provide for the naturalization of Deena Gilbey.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NATURALIZATION OF DEENA GILBEY.**

4 Notwithstanding title III of the Immigration and Na-
5 tionality Act (8 U.S.C. 1101 et seq.), Deena Gilbey shall
6 be entitled to naturalization as a citizen of the United
7 States upon being administered the oath of renunciation
8 and allegiance in an appropriate ceremony pursuant to
9 section 337 of the Immigration and Nationality Act. Upon
10 naturalization of Deena Gilbey under this Act, the Attor-

- 1 ney General shall record the date of naturalization of
- 2 Deena Gilbey as being September 10, 2001.
