2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. DESIGNATION OF EDWARD R. BECKER LOBBY.**

4 The lobby of the James A. Byrne United States
5 Courthouse located at 601 Market Street in Philadelphia,
6 Pennsylvania, shall be known and designated as the “Ed-
7 ward R. Becker Lobby”.

1 **SEC. 2. REFERENCES.**

2 Any reference in a law, map, regulation, document,
3 paper, or other record of the United States to the lobby
4 referred to in section 1 shall be deemed to be a reference
5 to the Edward R. Becker Lobby.
