## A BILL

To amend the Agriculture and Food Act of 1981 to require the Secretary of Agriculture to conduct a pilot program under which the Secretary shall make grants to local units of government or local nonprofit organizations in the State of Arkansas to employ non-Federal resource conservation and development coordinators.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
2       tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PILOT PROGRAM FOR RESOURCE CONSERVA-  
4       TION AND DEVELOPMENT COORDINATORS.**

5       Subtitle H of title XV of the Agriculture and Food  
6       Act of 1981 (16 U.S.C. 3451 et seq.) is amended—

5 "SEC. 1538. RESOURCE CONSERVATION AND DEVELOP-  
6 MENT COORDINATORS.

7       “(a) IN GENERAL.—The Secretary (acting through  
8 the Natural Resources Conservation Service) shall carry  
9 out a pilot program under which the Secretary shall make  
10 grants to local units of government or local nonprofit orga-  
11 nizations in the State of Arkansas to employ, and provide  
12 the necessary support for, a non-Federal resource con-  
13 servation and development coordinator (referred to in this  
14 section as a “non-Federal coordinator”) to assist in car-  
15 rying out this subtitle in the State.

16        "(b) VOLUNTARY PARTICIPATION.—The participa-  
17    tion of a local unit of government or local nonprofit orga-  
18    nization in the pilot program shall be voluntary.

19       “(c) ANNUAL REPORT.—A local unit of government  
20 or local nonprofit organization receiving a grant under this  
21 section shall submit to the Secretary an annual report that  
22 describes the activities of the non-Federal coordinator.

23        "(d) AMOUNT OF GRANT.—The total amount of a  
24 grant provided under this section to a local unit of govern-

1 ment or local nonprofit organization for a fiscal year shall  
2 be at least \$75,000.

3       “(e) FUNDING.—From funds made available under  
4 section 1538a, the Secretary shall use to carry out this  
5 section, \$\_\_\_\_\_ for each of fiscal years 2001  
6 through 2003.”.
