A BILL

To direct the Secretary of the Interior to make a grant to the Hubbard Museum of the American West in Lincoln County, New Mexico.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. HUBBARD MUSEUM OF THE AMERICAN WEST,**
4 **NEW MEXICO.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subject to the availability of ap-
6 propriations, the Secretary of the Interior shall make a
7 grant to the Hubbard Museum of the American West in
8 Lincoln County, New Mexico, to pay the Federal share
9 of the cost of expanding the museum.

1 (b) FEDERAL SHARE.—The Federal share shall be
2 75 percent.

3 (c) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—There is
4 authorized to be appropriated to carry out this section
5 \$4,500,000 for fiscal year 2003, to remain available until
6 expended.
